

What is required on my website? (100pts)

1. **Homepage:** About your gene and disease, references + world map of website viewers (5pts)
2. **Pages** for each lab/topic (i.e. DNA/Protein homologs, phylogeny, protein domains, RNAi/mutant phenotypes of your homologs, interaction networks, protein modifications) (30pts)

Each page should have this format (except homepage, specific aims, and conclusions page):

- Intro
- Results/Data Figures
- Discussion
- *References: Link out references to figures or paste links in Reference section

3. **Specific Aims:** most current version with text pasted on page + PDF. Plus all rough drafts (1 & 2) as Word/PDF files (Save as LastNameDraft1date.doc). So a total of 3 drafts and a pasted final version on the page + refs (15pts)
4. **Conclusions/Future Directions:** basically the written version of your final talk with figures on a separate page (25pts)
5. **Final Presentation:** PDF format of your talk on your Conclusions/Future Directions page. If too big, please upload in two versions: LastNameFinalPresentationPart1Date.pdf (5pts)
6. **Layout and navigation:** website is easy to navigate and visually appealing (10pts)
7. **Writing clarity:** (10pts)
8. **About me:** Optional but good
9. **Contact Info:** Good if you want readers to contact you (use an email you will use past graduation)
